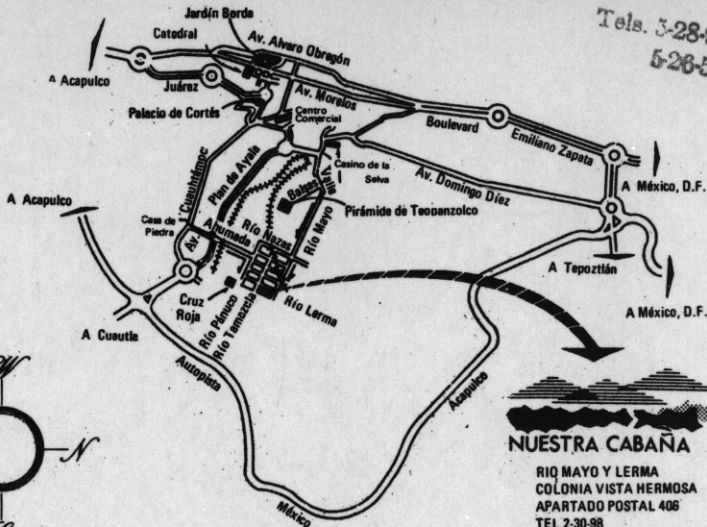

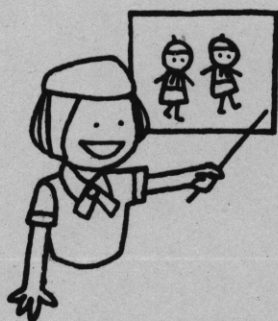
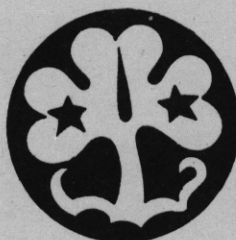

THINKING DAY - FEBRUARY 22, 1977

1976 A SPECIAL YEAR with SPECIAL FRIENDS and SPECIAL EVENTS for this World Center
— OUR CABAÑA.

The 1,464 girls, 562 adults and 249 visitors from 37 countries all shared international friendship as they lived with Mexican music, folk arts, fragrant flowers and the beautiful sunrises behind Popocatepetl.

For the first time, Our Cabaña held four ADULT ADVENTURE SESSIONS. 137 attended from Australia, Canada, Mexico, Panama, U.S.A., Jamaica Barbados and Costa Rica and discovered Mexico's Past and Present and the Life and Festivities of Mexico.

In the 19 REGULAR SESSIONS throughout the year, girls in troops from the far reaches of Canada to South America and coast to coast in the U.S.A. probed the challenge of World Hunger. Even a troop from Australia wended their way to the sunshine of Mexico.

The PROGRAM WORKSHOP was exceptionally helpful to the young leaders from 9 countries who shared proven program skills and enjoyed their own international event.

35 attended the SEMINAR FOR SPANISH SPEAKING TRAINERS and increased their proficiency and ability in helping adults better the Guiding/Scouting in the 15 countries represented.

"To deepen the understanding of Baden Powell's philosophy and its relativity to today's world" was the theme of the WORLD ASSOCIATION — JULIETTE LOW GATHERING FOR SENIOR/RANGERS. 49 young women talking to young women in expressions of 23 countries heard a special message from Dr. Gloria Scott, President of the Girl Scouts of the U.S.A. and spent many happy hours getting to know Lord Baden-Powell.

No session is complete without the sharing that is exchanged by the children and mothers at Gualupita with all of those from the Cabaña, nor the friends made at the Home for Girls where the common language is only a smile.

The close of another year has brought the members of OUR CABAÑA COMMITTEE, FRIENDS OF OUR CABAÑA COMMITTEE and the VISITORS PROGRAM from throughout the Western Hemisphere together for the annual meeting and the celebration of the 20th Anniversary of Our Cabaña. An incredible fiesta it was with flowers, folk dances and Mexican food galore. To the delight of the friends and visitors, many who were also present at the Dedication Ceremony in 1956, the Guías de México presented a program on the "Wearing of the Rebozo".

All shared in enjoying the Trefoil Birthday Cake with its 20 candles. How lucky we were to be saying HAPPY BIRTHDAY NUESTRA CABAÑA.

Farewell and thanks to Robyn Young, Program Director, for her years of service and Welcome to Barbara Wills who will be taking over this challenging job.

DIA DEL PENSAMIENTO - FEBRERO 22, DE 1977

1976 UN AÑO MUY ESPECIAL EN NUESTRA CABAÑA con EVENTOS INTERNACIONALES y la visita de NUEVAS Y VIEJAS AMIGAS a este Centro Mundial.

Las 1,464 muchachas Guías/Scouts, 562 dirigentes y 249 visitantes de 37 países, convivieron en este ambiente de amistad internacional, gozaron de la música mexicana, la fragancia de las flores y de la belleza de los amaneceres.

Por primera vez se celebraron en un año cuatro SESIONES DE AVENTURA PARA GUIADORAS, con asistencia de 137 personas de Australia, Canadá, México, Panamá, Estados Unidos, Jamaica, Barbados y Costa Rica. Los temas de las mismas fueron: "México, su Pasado y su Presente" y "Vida y Festividades en México".

Durante el año se celebraron 19 SESIONES REGULARES. Grupos de Guías de apartadas regiones del Canadá, de costa a costa de los Estados Unidos hasta la América del Sur, participaron en el reto sobre el "Problema Mundial de Alimentos". Por primera vez un grupo de Guías de Australia realizó su sueño de venir a Nuestra Cabaña.

La SESION DE INTERCAMBIO DE IDEAS SOBRE PROGRAMA fué muy valiosa para las jóvenes participantes de nueve países que intercambiaron ideas y experiencias y gozaron de este evento internacional.

35 personas participaron en el SEMINARIO INTERNACIONAL PARA INSTRUCTORAS DE HABLA HISPANA. Durante el mismo adquirieron conocimientos que ayudarán a mejorar el nivel del Guismo en los quince países representados.

"Profundizar el conocimiento de la Filosofía de Baden Powell y cómo se relaciona al mundo de hoy" fué el tema de la ASOCIACION MUNDIAL REUNION "JULIETTE LOW PARA GUIAS MAYORES". 49 jóvenes de 23 países compartieron experiencias, — escucharon un mensaje de la Dra. Gloria Scott, Presidenta de las Girl Scouts de los Estados Unidos y pasaron muchas horas tratando de conocer mejor a Lord Baden-Powell y su filosofía.

En ninguna sesión en Nuestra Cabaña puede faltar el intercambio de habilidades e ideas entre las Guías con los niños y señoras de la Parroquia de Gualupita, ni las nuevas amistades con las muchachas en la Casa de las Madres Trinitarias, en donde el idioma común es una sonrisa.

El final de otro año reunió nuevamente a los miembros del COMITE DE NUESTRA CABAÑA, AMIGOS DE NUESTRA CABAÑA y del PROGRAMA DE VISITANTES, para las reuniones anuales y la Celebración del XX Aniversario de Nuestra Cabaña. Nuestro cumpleaños lo celebramos con una Fiesta con bailes, flores y comida típica Mexicana. Para deleite de nuestros visitantes, muchos de los cuales estuvieron presentes en la Ceremonia de Dedicación en 1956, las Guías de México presentaron un programa sobre los diferentes usos del Rebozo. Todos saborearon el delicioso Pastel en forma de Trébol con sus 20 velitas. ¡Qué gusto dió poder decir FELIZ CUMPLEAÑOS NUESTRA CABAÑA!

Just think of all the extra room for souvenirs! We suggest durable new toys (cars, dolls, balls, boats) and we can use as many as you can provide. Perhaps troops in your community who know of your trip would like to become involved in this project.

We are also enclosing an attendance list of participants in case you wish to correspond and make arrangements for transportation or sightseeing in Mexico before the session.

We hope you have a chance to look over the list of Program Possibilities and tours sent you earlier. We will also have activities and resources related to the session theme. Look over all the possibilities and we will have a group planning session on arrival. We are certain you will arrive with both ideas and questions.

The cost of tours and program activities has increased slightly, due to everyday increase of cost of living. We will have information available on your arrival.
